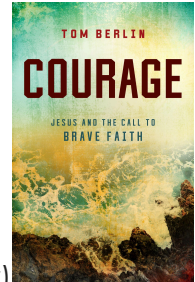
All-Church Lenten Study begins Today

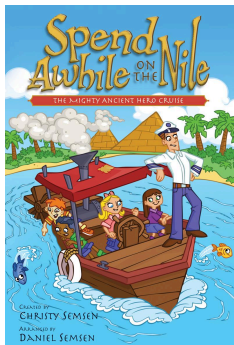


Leadership Board Information Sharing
