Clarendon UMC is a part of the worldwide United Methodist Church. We are governed by three bodies: the Judicial Council, the General Conference and the Council of Bishops. The General Conference meets every four years to set policy and pass legislation.

This month the General Conference, postponed from 2020, will meet April 21 through May 3 to participate in holy conferencing and to vote on legislation which revises or amends the Book of Discipline, the Book of Resolutions, and other official documents.




