Guest Preacher on May 4

Join us for a special worship service on Sunday, May 4 when we welcome the Rev. Pat Watkins, a retired elder and former missionary in the United Methodist Church who has long been a UM leader in environmental justice and the care of God's creation. Rev. Watkins had always been concerned about caring for the Earth, but never understood how that related to his Christian faith until, on a missionary assignment in an isolated Nigerian village in the mid-1990s, he learned to live far more simply and connected to the Earth. Upon returning home, Watkins sought answers by doing advanced study in both the Bible and environmental science, eventually leading him to a position alongside the UM Council of Bishops as a "Missionary to God's Creation." Rev. Watkins will share with us some of his experiences and how we can respond to God's call to be stewards of the Earth.


