

Tree lot volunteers needed + update on tree delivery

The trees are arriving on **Saturday**, **Nov. 29**, later than expected, but we can save our first day on the tree lot with a few extra volunteers to help us pick up the trees from Vale UMC (our tree partners). Here's what we need:

- 1. Extra hands to help **at Vale UMC in Oakton** as we sort our trees from theirs and load them onto our U-Hauls to bring back to Clarendon. This will happen from 7AM until we are done. It's no more than two hours of volunteering. Drive yourself or arrange a carpool.
- 2. Extra hands **at CUMC** to help us unload the trees onto our lot. We would expect this to be from about 10-11AM. When two people carry a tree, they are very manageable!
