Advent Mission Projects Update

Thank you to everyone who supported our three Advent Mission projects, based on the gifts of the Magi. Your generous giving reflected Christmas' true meaning of love, hope, and compassion.

- Frankincense – Nourishment: At a time when food benefits have been cut for many, we donated 298 pounds of food to AFAC for our neighbors in need. We also donated pet food to the animal shelter, for distribution to pet owners who may have trouble feeding their pets right now.
- Gold: We donated 29 gift cards valued at approximately \$595 to the families at Bridges to Independence, so they would have the dignity of buying what they wanted and needed for Christmas.
- Myrrh – Comfort: And finally we packed almost 40 safe-haven kits of toiletries for the clients of a domestic violence shelter. We had so many additional toiletry donations that we could also donate to the homeless shelters.
